Convention

Ensure that all your members receive the information from ZI and that this is discussed by your club. Appoint your delegate/s, alternate/s or proxy at a club meeting. Your delegate/proxy can be given guidance on voting, but you must give your delegate the freedom to vote as seems appropriate on the day, after listening to discussion, and nominees' speeches.

From District 16 Rules of Procedure:

30. APPOINTMENT OF CLUB PROXY TO CONVENTION OR CONFERENCE

Any Club appointing a proxy for Convention or Conference shall pay directly to the proxy a minimum of half the basic registration fee to assist with the expenses incurred in attendance at Convention or Conference. This payment shall be a matter between the proxy and the club appointing her, and shall in no way affect the payment given to her by any other club. In return the proxy shall give an undertaking to participate in all business sessions, to provide a written report on return from Convention or Conference and to attend the Club in person if at all possible. The Club shall give their proxy guidelines on how they would wish their vote to be exercised at Convention or Conference. The proxy will be held by one delegate.

Zonta International Foundation Donations

To be recognised at convention donations have to be made to the ZI Foundation before April 30th. We do have until the end of May for the total that will be recognised for this biennium (as opposed to recognition at convention).

Club Treasurers should be working on receiving dues this month, so that Zonta International dues are paid by **June 1**st **at the latest**. Please don't leave it until the last minute. If you miss this deadline your club will be denied a vote at convention.

District dues should be received by the District 16 Treasurer by **July 1**st.

Membership and Member Information Changes

If you have not recently completed the **Club Officer Contact Information Form** please do this by **May 1st.** We are unusual in having so many clubs change in December, so all clubs are expected to notify changes by May 1st for the next Zonta year – June 1st to May 31st.

PLEASE remember to use the membership@zonta.org.nz email address for any member information, including new members, resigned members, changes of details, end of Zonta year officer details changes. Give this email address to any club officer notifying membership issues – secretary, treasurer, membership committee chair. If you send anything to ZI Member Records, copy this to our D16 membership email address.

It is important to note that **there is no communication between the ZI website and District 16's website.** You have to notify membership details to both ZI and D16, now that the membership forms are dealt with on-line. You can copy the ZI membership form and send to the D16 address.

Governor – to be informed of all changes, and to keep the District Directory up-to-date **Lt Governor** – responsible for District Membership so needs to know membership changes **Treasurer** – to know who has to pay District and ZI Dues, particularly between the annual payment dates

Secretary – to send a welcome letter and certificate to new members **Webmaster** –to make the necessary changes to the website information
