

ZONTA NZ WOMEN OF ACHIEVEMENT AWARDS 2019

In November 2019, Zonta International celebrates a century of working together to improve the lives of women and girls through service and advocacy.

In 2016, Zonta International District 16 (comprising Zonta Clubs throughout New Zealand) recognised 50 Women of Achievement. This was in celebration of the 50th anniversary of Zonta in New Zealand.

We now wish to celebrate Zonta International's centennial by identifying and celebrating the contribution of a further 50 Women of Achievement. These Women of Achievement are New Zealand women who have empowered women and girls within New Zealand and/or globally.

This nomination form is for the Zonta NZ Women of Achievement Awards 2019.

Your nominee may be well known within your local area, a household name or a quiet achiever.

The Zonta New Zealand Women of Achievement Awards 2019 will be announced on 8 November 2019.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Women eligible to be nominated are those who:
 1. are living, and
 2. are a New Zealand citizen or resident, and
 3. demonstrate:
 - active commitment to volunteerism;
 - leadership; and
 - a significant contribution to empowering women and girls in New Zealand and/or globally.
- Women who are deceased (and who died after 1 January 1966) are also eligible for nomination if during their lifetime, they were a New Zealand citizen or resident, and demonstrated the attributes in 3. above.
- Members of Zonta and members of the general public may be nominated.
- Women who have already been recognised as one of the 50 Women of Achievement in 2016 (see the list attached) are not eligible for nomination.
- A nominating organisation or individual may nominate one or more nominees.
- Each nomination must be on a separate nomination form and all requested information must be provided. Failure to provide the requested information may invalidate the nomination.
- A photograph of the nominee must be attached.
- Nominations must be received by the Chair, District 16 Centennial Anniversary Committee by midnight 30 April 2019 either by:
 - email to zontawoa@outlook.co.nz or
 - post to Zonta WoA Awards, 21/3 Byron Street, Miramar, Wellington 6022.
- Awards are subject to the nominee consenting to publication of their name, photo and achievements in connection with the Women of Achievement 2019 Awards and the celebrations for Zonta International's centennial. This consent requirement does not apply if the nominee is deceased.

SELECTION PROCESS

- A District 16 appointed evaluating committee will review the nominations and select 50 Women of Achievement 2019.
- The recipients are subject to confirmation by the Zonta District 16 Board and the selection decision of the Zonta District 16 Board is final.
- The 50 recipients will be advised of their selection and a certificate will be provided. The recipients will receive no financial award.
